

# **Messianic Jewish Prayers for Financial Provision and Abundance**

## **Prayer for Wisdom and Skill to Earn Wealth**

*Baruch atah Adonai Eloheinu, Melech ha'olam, noten da'at l'adam.*

Blessed are You, Lord our God, King of the universe, who gives knowledge to humanity.

Abba Father, as it is written in Your Torah, "Remember that it is Adonai your God who gives you the power to get wealth" (Deuteronomy 8:18). I come before You seeking the wisdom, skills, and discipline to earn wealth according to Your will. Just as You filled Bezalel with Your Spirit, with wisdom, understanding, and knowledge for every kind of craftsmanship (Exodus 31:3), fill me with Your divine wisdom.

Guide my hands in my work and sharpen my mind in my decisions. May I honor You through diligent stewardship of the talents and opportunities You provide. Like Joseph who administered with excellence, grant me discernment to manage resources wisely and recognize the season of abundance and preparation.

## **Prayer for Success with Customers and Business Relationships**

## **Prayer to Be a Blessing to Others**

*Baruch atah Adonai Eloheinu, Melech ha'olam, shehecheyanu v'kiyemanu v'higiyanu lazman hazeh.*

Holy One, blessed be He, Your Word promises that when we delight ourselves in You, You will give us the desires of our heart (Psalm 37:4). I place my financial desires before You, trusting that You hear my prayers and know my needs even before I ask.

Creator God, You have made us in Your image as co-creators and called us to partner with You in tikkun olam—repairing the world. I pray for wealth not merely for personal comfort, but that I might participate more fully in Your redemptive work.

Grant me prosperity that I may fund Kingdom initiatives, support those who minister full-time, provide for widows and orphans, and invest in ventures that bring healing and restoration to Your creation. Like Queen Esther who used her position of privilege "for such a time as this," help me steward influence and resources for Your purposes.

May my financial success become a testimony to Your faithfulness and generate ripples of positive change throughout my community and beyond. Let me model the teaching of Yeshua that "From everyone who has been given much, much will be demanded" (Luke 12:48).

## **Daily Prayer for Divine Economy**

*Baruch atah Adonai Eloheinu, Melech ha'olam, ha'meichin mitz'adei gaver.*

Adonai, our Provider, as I begin this day, I acknowledge that all wealth and honor come from You alone. Like the manna You provided in the wilderness, teach me to gather what I need for today while trusting in Your provision for tomorrow.
